Kristu Jayanti University to open 14-acre tech & mgmnt campus on Airport Road

Bengaluru: Kristu Jayanti University will open a 14-acre campus dedicated to its management and technology programmes on Chagalatti, Bagalur, on Airport Road. The campus will be inaugurated Monday.

The new campus, which comes within a year of the institution receiving deemed-to-be university status, houses academic blocks, laboratories, incubation facilities, and other student amenities. The academic infrastructure includes collaborative classrooms, student lounges, and entrepreneurial workspaces.

The campus is expected to host 4,500 students and more than 200 faculties for its programmes ranging

from MBA international business, fintech, executive MBA; MCA, MSc data science, MSc cyber security, BBA with varied specialisations.

Student facilities include a library, student centre, food courts, yoga centre, gymnasium, auditoria, sports and games facilities and recreational areas. The campus also incorporates sustainability features such as rainwater harvesting, a sewage treatment plant, solar

panels and water management systems. It has provisions for a specially abled-friendly environment.

Kristu Jayanti University is managed by the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) Fathers. The college, with over 18,000 students, was ranked 34th in the college category of the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2025 and received deemed university status on July 8, 2025.
