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Jayantian Cup 2026 to Begin in Bengaluru

Kristu Jayanti University will host the fifth edition of the Jayantian Cup 2026, a national-level inter-institution championship, from September 9 to 11 at its Airport Road and Central campuses in Bengaluru. The three-day sporting event will be inaugurated at 9 a.m. on September 9 and is expected to bring together nearly 150 teams from educational institutions across the country.

The championship will feature competitions in basketball, volleyball, throwball, football, kabaddi, karate, taekwondo and pencak silat,

with events being conducted for both men and women. The university said the tournament is aimed at promoting sporting excellence, teamwork and greater interaction among student athletes from institutions across India.

The Jayantian Cup has emerged as a platform for young athletes to compete at the national level while encouraging a spirit of discipline, collaboration and healthy competition among participating institutions. The event will also provide students an opportunity to showcase their sporting abilities across a wide range of team and individual disciplines.

The competitions will be held across the university's Airport Road Campus and Central Campus during the three-day championship. The organisers have invited members of the media to attend and cover the event.
